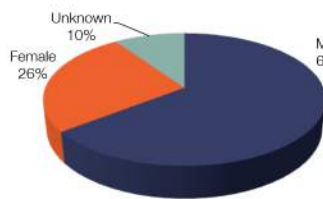

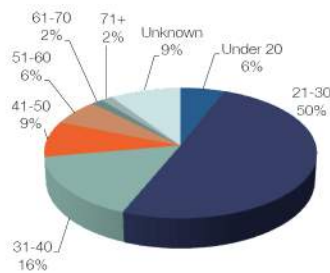

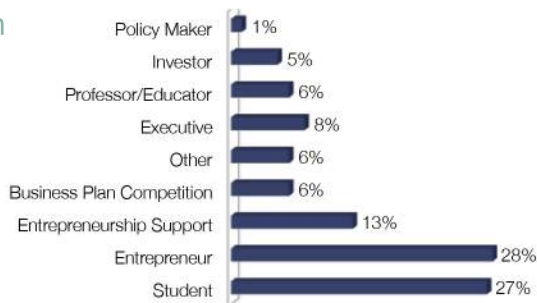
Gender
